INTRODUCED BY COMMISSIONER WALDRON

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF ST. JOHNS, STATE OF FLORIDA,
REZONING LANDS AS DESCRIBED HEREINAFTER FROM THE PRESENT
ZONING CLASSIFICATION OF RS-3 TO CI.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to the application of

GEORGE and MARTHA ARMSTRONG

zoning classification of RS-3 on the following described lands:

Lots 2 and 3, Block M, College Park Subdivision,

is hereby changed to CI.

SECTION 2. Nothing herein contained shall be deemed to impose conditions, limitations, or requirements not applicable to all other land in the zoning district wherein said lands are located.

SECTION 3. The Zoning Inspector is authorized to issue construction permits allowed by classification as reoned hereby.
