

RESOLUTION NO. 91-169

A RESOLUTION BY THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS URGING SUPPORT FROM THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY LEGISLATIVE DELEGATION FOR FUNDING FROM THE EROSION CONTROL TRUST FUND BUDGET FOR FISCAL 1992-93 FOR OFF BEACH PARKING IMPROVEMENTS AT MICKLER'S CUTOFF.

WHEREAS, there exists a critical need in the northeast area of the County for off beach parking at Mickler's Cutoff and this demand will only increase in the future as the area continues to grow and

WHEREAS, St. Johns County in an effort to alleviate this critical need has made application to the State of Florida, Department of Natural Resources, Bureau of Beaches and Shores for funding in the amount of \$682,500 to provide additional off beach parking and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Natural Resources, Division of Beaches and Shores and the Governor and Cabinet have approved the Fixed Capital Outlay Legislative Budget request for FY 92-93 including the Mickler's Cutoff Beach Parking project in the amount of \$294,375 and

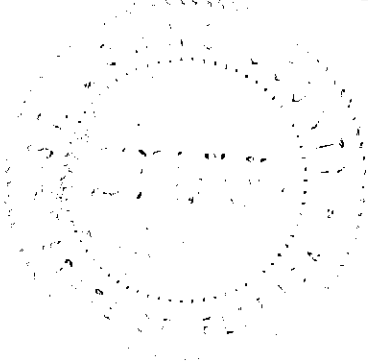
WHEREAS, without these funds additional parking facilities can not be created and

WHEREAS, St. Johns County has cooperated closely in the past with the Department of Natural Resources in its request for assistance most recently at Anastasia State Park in approving a request from DNR to amended an earlier agreement that required a South entrance be constructed at the park.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the St. Johns County Board of Commissioners that members of the St. Johns County legislative delegation be encouraged to take an active lead in supporting and assuring the approval of funding from the Florida Legislature for the beach parking facility at Mickler's Cutoff from the Erosion Control Trust Fund.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution becomes effective immediately upon adoption.
