ORDER GRANTING TEMPORARY
USE PERMIT

The above-referenced applicant requested a temporary use permit pursuant to the St. Johns County Zoning Ordinance to allow for hot dog sales and car washes as fund raisers for the cheerleading squad on the following dates: June 20, 1992; July 18, 1992; September 26, 1992; October 17, 1992; November 7, 1992; and December 5, 1992. The hot dog sales and car washes would be held at the Wal-Mart shopping center, 1940 U.S. #1 South, St. Augustine, Florida.

FINDINGS OF FACT

Having considered the application and supporting documents, and the applicant's statements at the June 9, 1992 Board of County Commissioners meeting, the Board of County Commissioners makes the following findings of fact:

1. TUP-92-006 has been fully considered after public hearing pursuant to legal notice duly published as required by law in the St. Johns County Zoning Ordinance;

2. The request is consistent with the requirements of section 10-12 of the St. Johns County Zoning Ordinance;

3. The application is supported by Wal-Mart, as is evidenced by a letter from George Schnichels, store manager, Wal-Mart store #579 dated May 19, 1992.

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners hereby grants the temporary use permit, TUP-92-006 as follows:

1. The St. Augustine High School Varisty Cheerleader Booster Club may hold hot dog sales and car washes as fund raisers for the St. Augustine High School cheerleading squad on the following dates: June 20, 1992; July 18, 1992; September 26, 1992; October 17, 1992; November 7, 1992 and December 5, 1992;

2. The hot dog sales shall be held at the Wal-Mart shopping center, 1940 U.S. #1 South, St. Augustine, Florida on the sidewalk between the front door and garden center;

3. The car wash and grill to cook the hot dogs shall be located on the north end of the Wal-Mart building.

4. At no time shall the operations of the applicatant impede the movement of cars through the shopping center; block fire lanes for emergency access; or block doors into and out of the Wal-Mart store.

5. The fee paid by the applicant for this application shall be refunded.
